If you bring your appliance to the Clean up it is a \$10 fee to dispose of it and \$10 for each additional. They will still do Curbside pick up on the following Monday, October 12 with a \$25 fee for the first appliance and \$10 for each one after. There is an up charge of \$5 on Water softeners and air conditioners.

Fees: The cost will be \$15 for a car, \$20 for a pick-up truck, SUV, minivan, trailer or station wagon, and \$30 for larger loads. Additional charges include \$5 per electronic item, \$10 for console TVs, (keyboards and computer mouse are free) \$2 for car tires, \$3 for truck tires, \$7 per semi tire, \$30 per tractor tire. There will also be a charge of \$10 per mattress and \$10 per box spring.
