Sidewalk Construction is Happening in Your Neighborhood in 2018

Expo Area Safe Route to School Sidewalk Infill Project

What is happening?

We will be constructing new sidewalks in your neighborhood where there are currently no sidewalks to create a complete sidewalk network and ensure safe routes to school. New sidewalks will align with existing ones and will be approximately 6 feet wide.

Where is it happening?

New sidewalks will be installed where there are gaps on the streets between Randolph Ave, Hamline Ave, Highland Pkwy and Snelling Ave. See map on other side for more detail.

When is it happening?

New sidewalk construction is scheduled during the summer of 2018. A **Notice of Sidewalk Work** will be mailed to each resident directly affected by construction approximately two weeks before start of construction.

How will it benefit you?

The project includes new sidewalks and construction of ADA compliant pedestrian ramps at the intersections.

How will it impact you?

- **Existing Boulevard Gardens and Sprinklers**
This project will impact the boulevard. If you have personal property, plantings, or sprinkler systems in the boulevard, please **remove them** prior to construction or they may become damaged.
- **Driveway Aprons**
This project may impact your driveway apron. Public Works staff will work with residents impacted by driveway work.

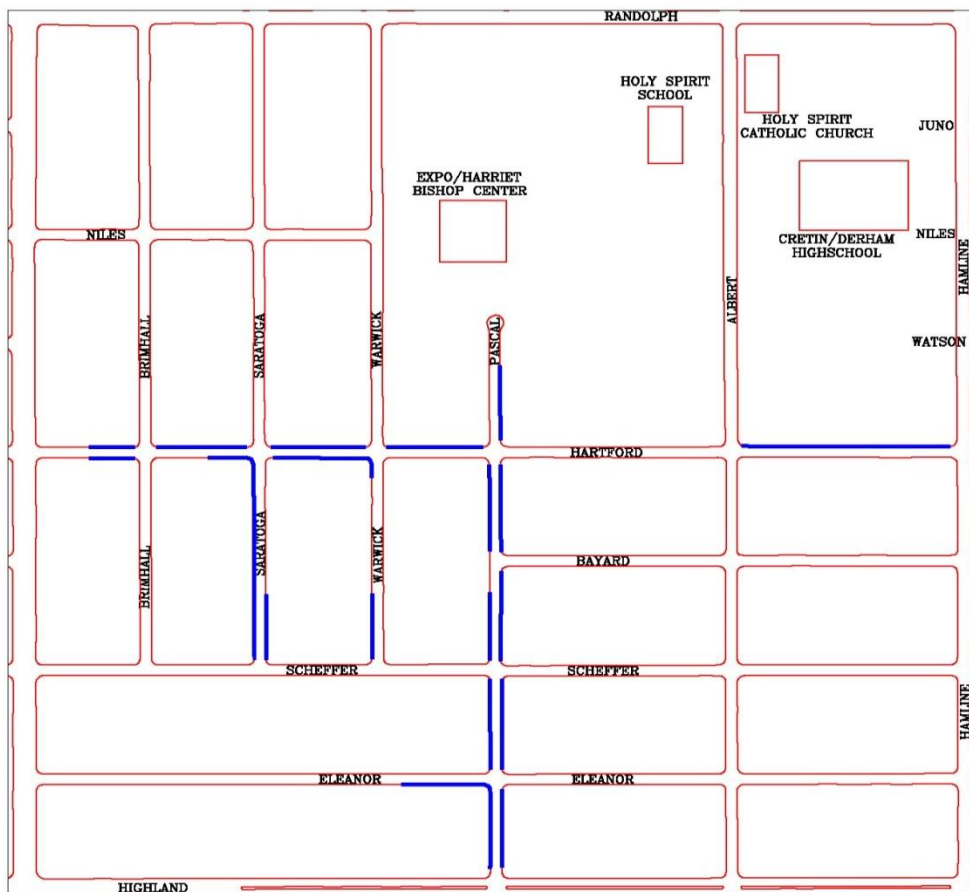
