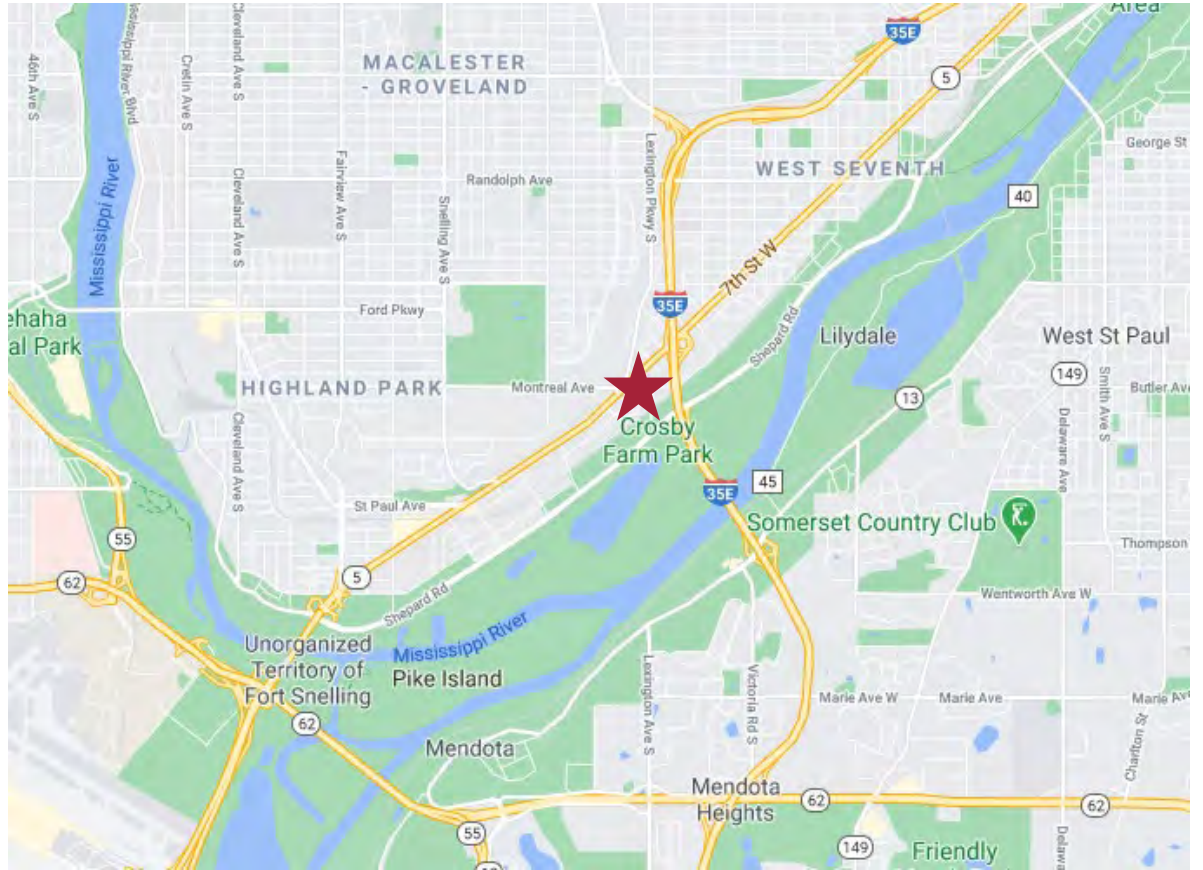

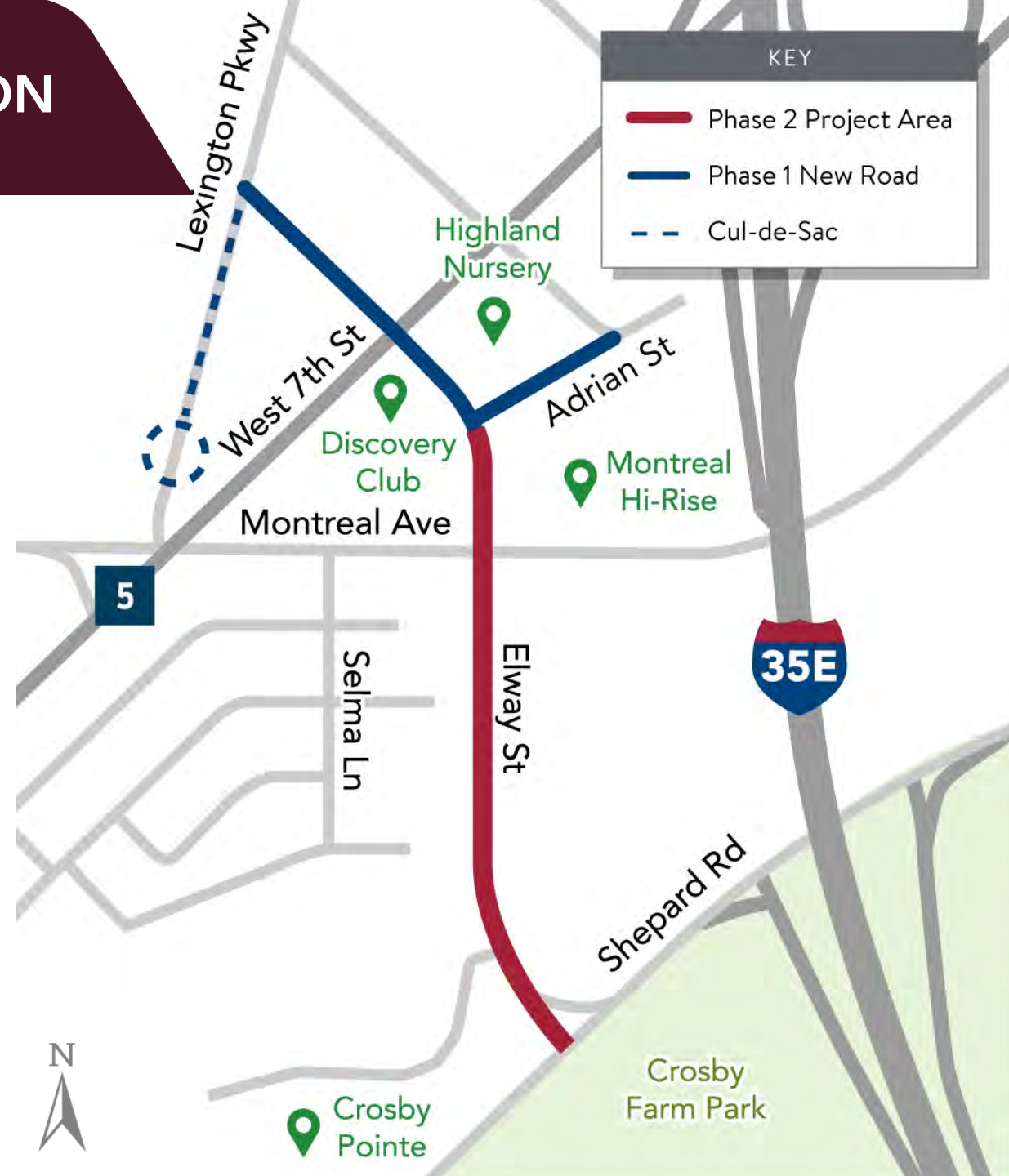
LEXINGTON PARKWAY RECONSTRUCTION

- Located in the Highland and West 7th/Fort Road Federation and District Councils in Saint Paul
- Realignment will improve connections for local and regional travelers
- The city street (Elway Street) will be transferred to Ramsey County upon completion



LEXINGTON PARKWAY RECONSTRUCTION

- Phase 1 of the realignment north of Adrian Street is under construction and Phase 2 is in the discovery phase
- Phase 1 detached Lexington Parkway from intersection at West 7th Street and Montreal Avenue
- Phase 2 will extend Lexington Parkway from Adrian Street to Shepard Road

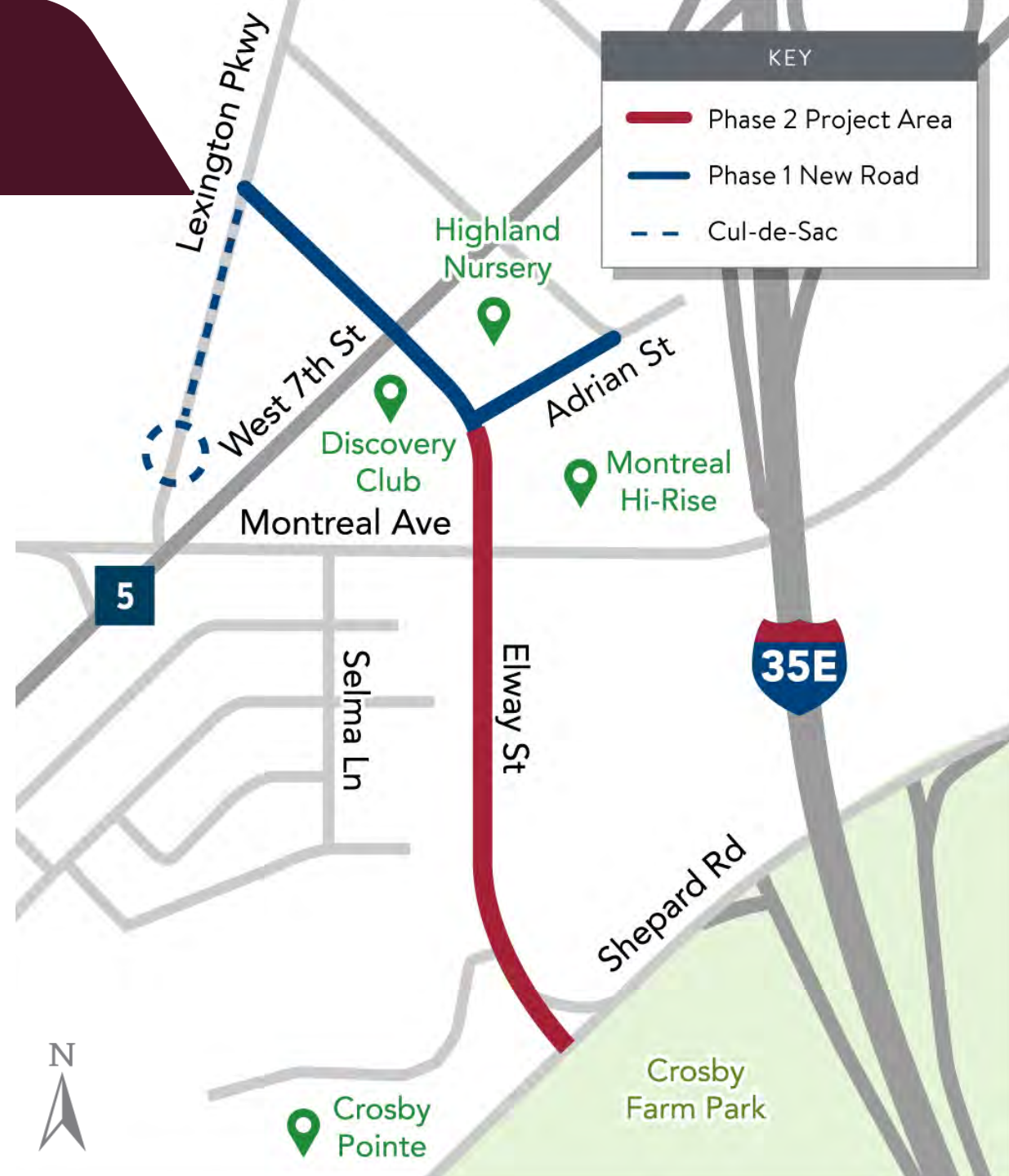
