## **C** is for **Crosby Park**

Explore over 6.5 miles of trails near the Mississippi River Crosby Farm Regional Park.

## **D** is for **Dead End**

There are several dead ends in Highland, including South Prior Avenue at the river.

## **E** is for **Electric Scooter**

Ride or pose next to it. Remember to wear your helmet!

## **F** is for **Field**

Find a field: A sports field, grassy field or Field Avenue.

## **G** is for **Golf**

Fun fact: There's a Snoopy-shaped bunker at Highland National. Take a picture of the course or clubhouse.

## **H** is for **"H" Park**

Homecroft, Hidden Falls, Highland or Hillcrest Park.

## **I** is for **Ice Castle**

A sign with an illuminated ice castle greets people as they enter The Village from the west.

## **J** is for **Joy**

## **K** is for **St. Kate's**

Explore the grounds at St. Catherine's University.

Find a hole: Construction-related, animal-related or a pothole.

## W is for Water Tower

Take a photo of the exterior of the Highland Water Tower at Snelling Ave. and Ford Pkwy.

## X is for Xinia Triangle

Alphabetically last among Saint Paul's parks. Check out the nearby Bohland Triangle.

## Y is for "Y" Street

Find a street in Highland Park that starts with the letter "Y".

## Z is for Zebra Crossing

Crosswalk design with white stripes painted on pavement are known as zebra crossings. Find a pedestrian crosswalk of any design in Highland.
