Approval of prior meeting minutes – Approved

Bike MN- CJ Lindor

- State and local advocacy more of a consulting role to communities
 - Events to promote biking across the state, and promote other community rides both weekly and larger rides
 - Education around safe riding using National League of American Bicyclist.
 - Teach adults how to ride a bikes and bike safety
 - Education to school kids around safe routes for biking and walking
 - Funding via foundations, events and small donors
 - E-bike policy (e-moto definition) if it runs like bike, under 20mph is a legal e-bike and regulated like a bike.
 - Supporting automated enforcement bill
 - Other contacts of support: Sustain St. Paul, St. Paul bike coalition
- **35 Bridge Project Update** – Michael Corbett, Kent Barnard, Kevin Walker, Dale Gade
 - Project overview Replace I-35 E bridge over Shepard Road (2026), Repair bridge over Mississippi boulevard and Shepard Road (2027)
 - Starting April 20th will start on bypass pending weather
 - Season long impact/Closures
 - Shepard Road will be closed for remainder of the construction season
 - West bound on Shepard Rd between Lexington to Otto
 - East bound Shepard Rd between Lexington and 35E
 - South bound I-35E entrance ramp from Shepard Rd
 - Short term impact
 - Month long closure North bound I 35E to Shepard Rd exit ramp

- Occasional closures on Shepard Rd between 35E ramp off ramp and Otto
- Sort term closures highway 5/ 7th street west
- Lane closure on I-35E
- Pedestrian trail access along Shepard Rd will be maintained
- Detour
 - Vehicle detour on west 7th from Lexington parkway and Otto Ave
 - Bike detour use tunnel of Sam Morgan regional trail
- Events and outreach into the community
 - Metro Council reached out to do emergency by bass sewer system along on 35-E pedestrian path
